

AD-31 MP3 Manager

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INTRODUCTION

The AD-31 MP3 Manager is a **Free** program for easily managing your MP3s used on the AD-31 Promotion-On-Hold Repeater. This program comes on the USB Flash Drive provided with the AD-31, but can also be downloaded from www.asitekman.com/ad-31.htm. This program takes the hassle out of updating which MP3s you want to play. When working with a dealer, this program easily allows you to drop the ZIP file of promotions onto the program to prepare your USB Flash Drive. The AD-31 MP3 Manager program is installed with **eight COPYRIGHT Free Generic Promotion-On-Hold** tracks to help you get up and running. Each time the program is run, it will automatically check for the latest version and install it if found.

USB FLASH DRIVES

The AD-31 is supplied with a USB Flash Drive, but allows any USB Flash Drives with the following specs:

- USB size of **32GB** or less
- **FAT/FAT32** formatted

MP3 AUDIO FILES

The AD-31 will allow most MP3 file formats, but the preferred format for BEST audio playback is as follow:

- ID3 V1, V1.1, or V2.2/3/4
- MPEG Layer I, II, or III
- Unprotected
- Constant Bitrate
- Sampling rate of **44.1Khz**
- **32 bit** samples
- Bitrate of **128Kbps**

NOTE: The MP3 file must have at least the **Title** ID3 tag.

MENU OPTIONS

MANUALS

This option lets you view the manual for the AD-31 Promotion-On-Hold repeater or this manual.

ABOUT

This opens a dialogue with information about the program and its licensing.

USB DRIVE ASSIGNMENT

This allows you to select the USB Flash Drive letter for USB transfers. To select the USB Flash Drive, do the following once it is inserted:

- Pull the **USB drive select box** down and select the drive that has your USB Flash Drive
- AD-31 MP3 Manager will now use this drive for all USB functions as shown here

CREATING A USB FLASH DRIVE FOR PLAYING

You can create a USB by adding/removing MP3s in the **Files to Transfer** list.

ADD NEW AVAILABLE MP3S

To add an MP3 to the list, either drag and drop a dealer prepared ZIP file onto the program window, drag and drop an MP3 file onto the program window, or click on the **Add New MP3s** button and select an MP3 using the dialogue box. Also, when you select a USB with MP3s, the system will prompt you to load them. **NOTE:** We've found the best quality for the MP3s is 44.1Khz sample rate, 32 bits, 128Kbps; other settings will still work, but they aren't as seamless. When you try to import a non-optimal MP3, the program will warn you, giving you the option to abort.

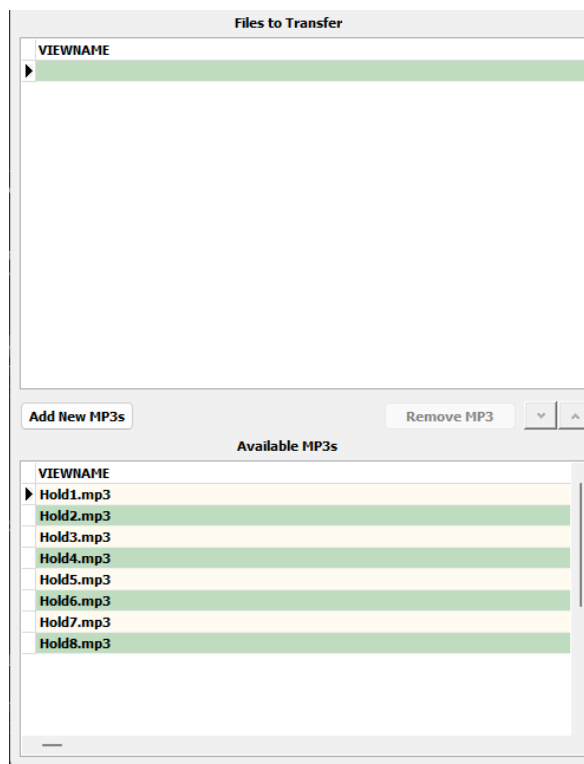
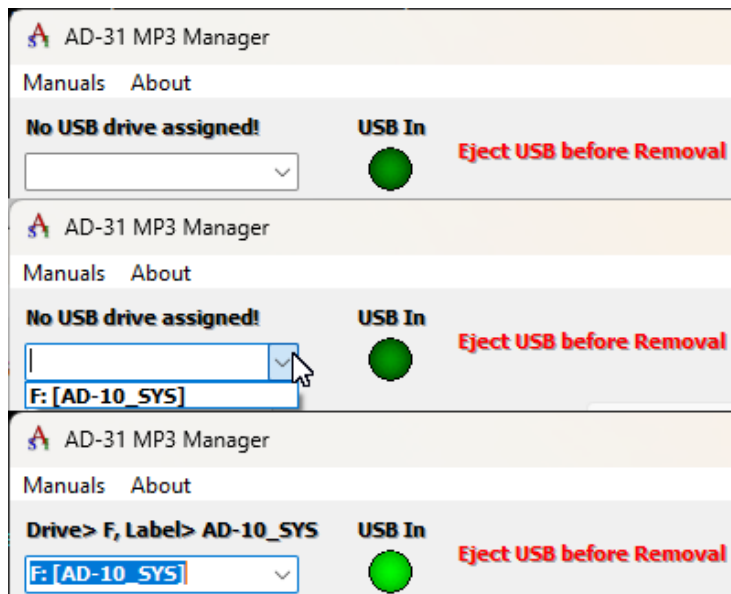
REMOVE AVAILABLE MP3S

To remove an MP3, just select the MP3 in the **Available MP3s** list and click the **Remove MP3** button, then confirm the removal.

CREATE THE TRANSFER LIST

To add an MP3 to transfer, click on an MP3 in the **Available MP3s** list box, then click the **UP** button.

To remove an MP3 from the transfer, click on the file in the **Files to Transfer** list, then click the **DOWN** button. **NOTE:** You can only remove an MP3 from the **Files to Transfer** list when more than 1 MP3 file is in the list.



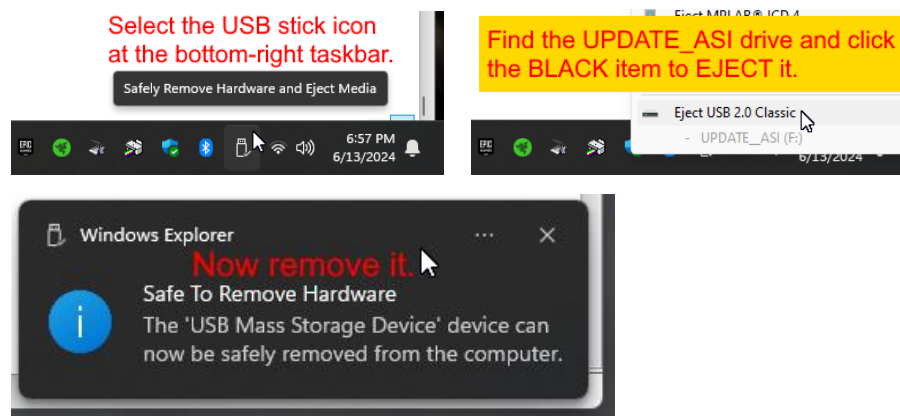
TESTING AN MP3

You can listen to any of the MP3 files, regardless of the list, by selecting the file then clicking the **Play** button, shown on the right.

CREATE THE PLAYABLE USB FLASH DRIVE

Once you've set up your **Files to Transfer** list and selected the USB drive to use, just click the **Transfer MP3s** button to finish the process. **NOTE:** This will format the USB Flash Drive.

Make sure you **Safely Eject** the USB Flash Drive from the **System Tray** (usually at the bottom-right on the desktop) by following these steps:



LOADING MP3 PLAY LISTS FROM DEALERS

When you have a dealer create a play list of MP3 files with the AD-31 MP3 Manager program, they can create a ZIP file and email it to you. To install the list, simply drag and drop the ZIP file onto the AD-31 MP3 Manager icon, or the running program, and the list will load and be ready to transfer automatically. If you can't drag the ZIP from the email, then save it to the **Desktop** first. If the dealer sends you a USB with the MP3s on it, then just run the program and select the USB in the Drive Select box; you'll automatically be prompted to load the files.
